Do you know an outstanding ACA International Affiliate Member?

Purpose

This award recognizes an ACA International Affiliate member who best exemplifies leadership qualities and dedication to the credit and collections industry.

Qualifications

Minimum qualifications of candidate:

ACA International will determine these qualifications when nomination form is received:

- 1) The candidate's company must be a current member in good standing (2011 calendar year).
- 2) The candidate's company must have been a member in good standing for the past two consecutive fiscal years:
 - June 1, 2009 – December 31, 2009
 - January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010
- 3) The candidate must have also attended at least two ACA International expositions, as an exhibitor, between April 1, 2009 and April 1, 2011.

Additional qualifications of candidate:

In addition to the above minimum qualifications, the candidate must have met at least three of the following qualifications. A 30-75 word paragraph must be submitted for each qualification below explaining the candidate's participation.

- (1) ACA membership recruitment efforts
- (2) Actively participates at the individual unit levels and in unit meetings
- (3) Attends the Affiliate Member meeting at the ACA Convention
- (4) Has served on an ACA committee within the last 5 years
- (5) Support and participation in ACA legislative activity
- (6) Contribution of articles and/or information to ACA publications
- (7) Contribution of articles and/or information to the ACA Web site
- (8) Presentations at ACA conventions and meetings

Checklist for Nomination Submissions

- 1) Completed Nomination Form
- 2) Identify a minimum of three of the "Additional qualifications of candidate" as listed above, and submit a 30-75 word paragraph for each qualification. Supporting documents may be submitted for each qualification.
- 3) Optional materials to submit:
 - Statement from the individual's employer or co-worker
 - Statement from the person making the nomination
 - List of other contributions to the credit and collections industry with supporting documents

Additional Information

Only ACA International members are eligible to make a nomination for this award. The award winner will be selected by the ACA International Executive Committee and will be recognized at the 72nd Annual Convention & Expo at the Hilton Anatole in Dallas, TX between July 13-15, 2011. Award winner will be notified in advance of the Annual Convention when a photo will be requested. Registration for the Annual Convention is not provided. In the case that the award winner cannot attend the Annual Convention, the award winner will still be recognized and the recognition plaque will be mailed to him/her.
